It is with much pleasure that the United Methodist Women of Wesley Memorial United Methodist Church extend to you an application to participate in our long-standing tradition of our Annual *Carolina Christmas Bazaar*. This year's Bazaar will be held **November 21, 2020 from 8:00 am to 3:00 pm** in Wesley Memorial United Methodist Church's Fellowship Hall and Dining Hall with over 75 vendors, Silent Auction, General Store, Bake Sale and Food Cafe. The Bazaar will be advertised throughout Archdale, Greensboro, High Point, Jamestown and Thomasville.

We invite you to participate by bringing your handcrafted work to sell at the Bazaar. Spaces are approximately 8' X 10', include two chairs, and rent for \$75.00. Only one vendor per space with no sub-leasing allowed. Tables, 8' X 3', are available for rent for \$5.00 each subject to availability. We also suggest that you bring tablecloths and displays to make your booth more attractive. Designate if you need one of the limited spaces with access to electrical outlets, and you will need to provide your own 25' extension cord. Vendors are responsible for their own set-up on Friday, November 15 at 3-7:00 pm and Saturday morning beginning at 6:30 am. Vendors are required to clean-up their own area before leaving. The United Methodist Women or Wesley Memorial United Methodist Church will not be responsible for any theft, damage or personal injury while on church property.

As there are a limited number of spaces and a long waiting list, we give first priority to our returning vendors. Vendors that participated in the 2019 Carolina Christmas Bazaar must submit an application and check before June 1, 2020 to retain their space. Checks should be made payable to "Wesley Memorial United Methodist Church" and please put <u>Carolina Christmas Bazaar</u> in the memo line. New vendors are chosen as space becomes available. We strive for variety, quality and give preference to handcrafted items created by the vendor. New vendors should submit an application, pictures of the art, craft or product you will sell and check(s) no later than September 4, 2020. Your payment will not be deposited until you have been notified of acceptance and will be returned if the review committee determines your work is not appropriate for the Bazaar or if space is not available.

As in years past, we expect enthusiastic shoppers and with your participation, we can ensure the success of this event. Please contact me if you have any questions, suggestions or special needs.
